



I FOUND A BABY

Is the baby visibly injured, cold, or in danger?

Baby mammals look surprisingly similar. They have one thing in common, though: they need to be kept warm and safe. If the baby is in danger, crying, or injured, please keep the baby warm in a small box or kennel with soft bedding (paper products, a t-shirt, or fleece) in a quiet, dark place. Contact a wildlife rehabilitator for more guidance.

If the baby is not injured or in danger.

Leave it and see if the mother comes back to get it. If the mother does not return, please keep the baby warm in a small box or kennel with soft bedding (paper products, a t-shirt, or fleece) in a quiet, dark place and contact a wildlife rehabilitator.

Do not feed or give water.
